## **Rationale**

## **School Uniform Expectations**

Here at Reynalds Cross we actively encourage pupils to wear school uniform. This would be while on the school premises; travelling to and from school; and trips that are organised by the school unless stated otherwise.

White or light blue polo shirt

Grey trousers, joggers, skirt or pinafore

Sixth form students

Year 12 -14 students are not required to wear school uniform

### Swimming

Swimming costumes/trunks

Towel

### P.E.

T-shirt

Shorts

Plimsolls

Clothing showing the school logo is recommended.

It is recommended that items of clothing and footwear are name labelled so that items can be returned.

### **Monitoring arrangements**

This policy will be reviewed every 2 years, or earlier if the need arises by the Senior Leadership Team. At every review, it will be approved by the Head Teacher.
