It remains for me to wish you a very happy, safe and healthy summer and I look forward to seeing everyone back at school in September.










Action words

Alongside this, Pupils have continued to work on self-care this half term, practicing hair and teeth brushing, and have practiced pen control and straight line drawing in Writing.





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
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


Rainbows














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Numbers and shapes




