



Learning and Pupil Progress Committee Terms of Reference 2020/2021

1. Purpose of the Group

To challenge the school to raise and maintain the standards of pupil attainment through high quality teaching and a broad, pupil centred, flexible and responsive curriculum that places life skills at its core.

2. Aims and Objectives

- 2.1 To monitor, support and challenge the Senior Leadership Team on the raising of standards and achievements, linked to the quality of teaching.
- 2.2 To consider curricular issues which have implications for Finance and Personnel decisions and to make recommendations to the relevant committees or Governing Body.
- 2.3 To monitor the development of curriculum, related to the School Development Plan (SDP) in order to raise standards.
- 2.4 To monitor challenging behaviour its impact on effective teaching and learning.
- 2.5 To monitor educational visits to ensure they reinforce curricular entitlement and provide students with opportunities to develop life skills.
- 2.6 To monitor and support the transition of pupils throughout school and onward into adult life.
- 2.7 To regularly receive and monitor Pupil Achievement.
- 2.8 To monitor the impact of Pupil Premium and other funded interventions on pupil progress.
